Magnets for sex trafficking include: tourists, a strong economy, and the convergence of multiple interstate highways.



Human trafficking is a low-risk, high-reward crime and multi-billion-dollar business impacting 25 million individuals worldwide.



Human trafficking is as common in rural and suburban areas as it is in urban areas.



Risk factors for trafficking:

- economic disparity
- housing insecurity
- runaways
- foster care
- history of childhood sexual abuse
- mental illness
- substance abuse
- systemic oppression




